Observations:

- The figures quoted are not final and are in the process of going through verification checks, this means that the totals may be subject to change, although it is anticipated that this will be marginal and the general trend will remain the same.
- Steady progress has been made in reducing emissions representing a 23.8% reduction from the 09/10 baseline.
- This represents a saving in energy bills of approximately £104,670 from the Council's Corporate estate and £265,000 for Schools.
- The impact of milder winter in 2013/14 should be noted, especially when it comes to scope 1 CO₂ emissions.
- Reduction in emissions from schools has been delivered through much improved engagement with schools on energy issues.
