- 2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into operation, the provisions of the "Bedfordshire County Council (District of Mid Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008" shall be varied as follows:-
 - (i) The plan schedule reference "Area Code BC 84: Sheet Revision Number 1" shall be deleted and Area Code BC 84: Sheet Revision Number 2" shall be substituted.

On 24th June 2011 Central Bedfordshire Council made a Road Traffic Regulation Order as follows:

Effect of the Order:

To introduce No Waiting at Any Time on the following lengths of road in Henlow Camp:-

- The Bedford Road/Hitchin Road service road, north-west side from Bedford Road in a generally south—easterly direction for a distance of approximately 29 metres.
- The Bedford Road/Hitchin Road service road, north side from Hitchin Road in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 5 metres.
- The Bedford Road/Hitchin Road service road, south side from Hitchin Road in a generally westerly direction for a distance of approximately 50 metres.

To revoke the existing No Waiting at Any Time restrictions on the following length of road in Henlow Camp:-

Hitchin Road, south-east side from a point 8.7 metres north-east of the boundary between nos.
 247 and 249 Hitchin Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 31.6 metres.

To introduce On-Street Parking Places on the following length of road in Henlow Camp:-

• The Bedford Road/Hitchin Road service road, south—west side, from a point 9.2 metres north-west of the southern flank wall of nos.1-13 Karen House in a south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 15 metres.

<u>To introduce On–Street Parking for Places for Motorcycles on the following length of road in Henlow Camp:-</u>

 The Bedford Road/Hitchin Road service road, south-east side from a point 7.8 metres southeast of the southern flank wall of nos.1-13 Karen House in a south easterly direction for a distance of approximately 4.3 metres.

Orders to be revoked: All previous Waiting Restriction Orders made on the above lengths of road are revoked.

<u>Date of Operation:</u> The Order will come into operation on the 4th July 2011.

<u>Further Details:</u> of the Order and a plan may be examined during normal office hours at Central Bedfordshire Council address below and normal opening hours at Shefford Library, 1 High Street, Shefford SG17 5DD.

<u>High Court Challenge:</u> Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant Section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the ground that any requirement of that Section had not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the 24th June 2011 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
