- This Order shall come into operation on 26th day of September 2011 and may be cited as "Central Bedfordshire Council (Bedfordshire County Council (District of Mid Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008) (Variation No 16) Order 2011."
- As from the date upon which this Order comes into operation, the provisions of the "Bedfordshire County Council (District of Mid Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008" shall be varied as follows:-
 - (i) The plan schedule reference "Area Code BN 30: Sheet Revision Number 2" shall be deleted and Area code BN 30: Sheet Revision Number 3" shall be substituted.

On 16th September 2011 Central Bedfordshire Council made a Road Traffic Regulation Order as follows:

Effect of the Order:

To introduce No Loading/Unloading in Sun Street and Market Square, Potton between the hours 7.30am to 9.30am and 4.30pm to 6.00pm Monday to Friday, on the following lengths of road:

- 1. Sun Street, east side from a point in line with the southern flank wall of no.22 Sun Street, northwards to a point 9 metres north of the boundary of no.5 Sun Street and Royston Court.
- 2. Sun Street, west side form a point in line with the southern flank wall of no.22 Sun Street, northwards to Market Square.
- 3. Market Square, west side from Sun Street northwards to a point approximately 3 metres north of the boundary of no.2 and no.3 Market Square.

Date of Operation: The Order will come into operation on the 26th September 2011.

<u>Further Details</u> of the Order and a plan may be examined during normal office hours at Central Bedfordshire Council at the address below and during normal opening hours at Potton Library, Clock House, Potton, SG19 2NP.

<u>High Court Challenge:</u> Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant Section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the ground that any requirement of that Section had not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the 16th September 2011 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
