ENFORCEMENT AREA AND SPECIAL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND
STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION) ORDER 2008

The Council of the County of Bedfordshire ('the Council') in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 15th day of September 2008 and may be cited as "Bedfordshire County Council (District of South Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) (Variation) Order 2008"
2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into operation, the provisions of the "Bedfordshire County Council (District of South Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008" shall be varied as follows:-

The plan schedule reference "Area Code F 125: Sheet Revision Number – 2" shall be deleted and plan schedule reference "Area Code F 125: Sheet Revision Number – 3" shall be substituted.

Bedfordshire County Council (District of South Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Variation Order 2008

On the 5th September 2008 Bedfordshire County Council made a Road Traffic Regulation Order as follows:

Effect of the Order: -

To Introduce No Waiting at Any Time on the following lengths of road in Leighton Buzzard:-

1. Millstream Way on the north side from its junction with Bassett Road in a westerly direction for a distance of approx 9 metres
2. Millstream Way on the south side from its junction with Bassett Road in a westerly direction for a distance of approx 9.5 metres
3. Bassett Road from its junction with Millstream Way in a northerly direction for a distance of approx 24 metres
4. Bassett Road from its junction with Millstream Way in a southerly direction for a distance of approx 12 metres

The Order is considered necessary on the grounds of promoting road safety and improving visibility for motorists entering and exiting Millstream Way, Leighton Buzzard. The restrictions are specifically aimed at restricting parking in the vicinity of Millstream Way at its junction with Bassett Road, and on Bassett Road in the vicinity of the Doctors Surgery.

Date of Operation: The Order will come into operation on the 15th September 2008.

Further Details of the Order and a plan showing the lengths of road affected may be examined during normal office hours at County Hall, Bedford and at Town Hall, St Paul's Square, Bedford.

High Court Challenge: Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant Section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the ground that any requirement of that Section had not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the 14th September 2008 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
