# BEDFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF SOUTH BEDFORDSHIRE) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA AND SPECIAL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION NO 2) ORDER 2008

The Bedfordshire County Council (the "Council") in exercise of the powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 17th day of November 2008 and may be cited as "Bedfordshire County Council (District of South Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) (Variation No 2) Order 2008"
- 2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into operation, the provisions of the "Bedfordshire County Council (District of South Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008" shall be varied as follows:-

The plan schedule reference "Area Code AI 149: Sheet Revision Number – 1" shall be added to the plans attached to the Order.

Bedfordshire County Council (District of South Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) (Variation No 2) Order 2008

On the 7th November 2008 Bedfordshire County Council made a Road Traffic Regulation Order as follows:

#### Effect of the Order:

## 1. To Introduce No Waiting Monday to Friday 7.00am to 6.00pm on the following lengths of road:-

- Southern side of Five Oaks, Caddington which extends from a point approx 5 metres east of the boundary of Nos 105/107 Five Oaks following the kerb radius at the T-Junction of the Five Oaks loop for approx 21 metres.
- Northern side of Five Oaks, Caddington which extends from a point approx 12 metres
  east of the boundary of Nos 28/30 Five Oaks following the kerb radius at the TJunction of the Five Oaks loop for approx 36.5 metres, to a point approx 3.3 metres
  south of the boundary of Nos 24/26 Five Oaks.
- Southern side of Five Oaks, Caddington which extends from a point approx 28 metres
  east of the boundary of Nos 85/87 Five Oaks following the kerb radius at the TJunction of the Five Oaks loop for approx 22 metres, to a point approx 13.5 metres
  north of the boundary of Nos 79/81 Five Oaks.

## 2. To Introduce No Stopping Monday to Friday from 7.00am to 6.00pm on School Entrance Markings on the following lengths of road:-

• Both sides of Five Oaks, Caddington which extend from a point approx 8 metres south east from the boundary of Nos 71/73 Five Oaks south east for approx 26 metres.

The Order is considered necessary on the grounds of promoting road safety. The restrictions are specifically aimed at controlling on-street parking in the vicinity of Caddington School (currently Five Oaks Middle and Willowfield Lower Schools) at the start and end of the school day. The Caddington School is to be participating in the 'extended schools' programme, hence the extended waiting restriction from 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday.

<u>Date of Operation:</u> The Order will come into operation on the 17th November 2008.

<u>Further Details</u> of the Order and a plan showing the lengths of road affected may be examined during normal office hours at County Hall, Bedford and normal opening hours at Dunstable Library, Vernon Place, Dunstable.

<u>High Court Challenge:</u> Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant Section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the ground that any requirement of that Section had not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the 16th November 2008 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
