As from the date upon which this Order comes into operation, the provisions of the "Bedfordshire County Council (District of South Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008" shall be varied as follows:-

The plan schedule reference "Area Code X 140 Sheet Revision No - 1" shall be deleted and "Area Code X 140 Sheet Revision No - 2" shall be substituted.

On the 13th March 2009 Bedfordshire County Council made a Road Traffic Regulation Order as follows:

Effect of the Order:

To Introduce No Stopping Monday to Friday inclusive from 8.00am to 4.30pm on the existing School Entrance Markings on the following lengths of road in Leighton Court, Dunstable:-

- 1. That length of Leighton Court, Dunstable which extends from a point 6.5 metres north east of the boundary between property Nos 47 and 48 Leighton Court in a south westerly direction for a distance of 26 metres.
- 2. That length of Leighton Court, Dunstable which extends from a point 6 metres north of the projected boundary between property Nos 19 and 20 in Leighton Court in a generally south then easterly direction for a distance of 26 metres.

<u>Date of Operation:</u> The Order will come into operation on the 23rd March 2009.

<u>Further Details</u> of the Order and a plan showing the lengths of road affected may be examined during normal office hours at County Hall, Bedford and normal opening hours at Dunstable Library, Vernon Place, Dunstable.

<u>High Court Challenge:</u> Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant Section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the ground that any requirement of that Section had not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the 19th March 2009 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
