CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (BEDFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF SOUTH BEDFORDSHIRE) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA AND SPECIAL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2008) (VARIATION NO 8) ORDER 2010

On the 26th February 2010 Central Bedfordshire Council made a Road Traffic Regulation Order as follows:

Effect of the Order:

A. To introduce no waiting, 8am to 9am and 3pm to 4pm Monday to Friday inclusive on the following length of road:

On the eastern side of the A4012 Woburn Road, Hockliffe which extends from a point approx 2 metres south of the boundary between property Nos 7 and 8 Woburn Road north east for approx 56 metres.

B. To introduce No Stopping, 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday inclusive on the following lengths of road:

On the western side of the A4012 Woburn Road, Hockliffe which extends from the boundary between property Nos 4 and 5 Old School Court north east for approx 32 metres.

On the western side of the A4012 Woburn Road, Hockliffe which extends from a point approx 12 metres north of the northern flank wall of Hockliffe Lower School south west for approx 32 metres.

Date of Operation: The Order will come into operation on the 10th March 2010.

Further Details of the Order and a plan showing the lengths of road affected may be examined during normal office hours at the Customer Service Centre, High Street North, Dunstable.

High Court Challenge: Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant Section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the ground that any requirement of that Section had not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the 9th March 2010 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
