On the 9th April 2010 Central Bedfordshire Council made a Road Traffic Regulation Order as follows:

## Introduce No Waiting At Any Time on the following lengths of road in Biggleswade:-

Dells Lane: East side, from a point 18 metres north of the property boundary between Nos 25 and 27 Dells Lane, in a northerly direction for a distance of approx 39 metres.

Dells Lane: East side, from a point 17 metres south of the property boundary between Nos 45 and 47 Dells Lane, in a southerly direction for a distance of approx 40.5 metres.

Dells Lane: East side, from a point 16.5 metres south of the property boundary between Nos 53 and 55 Dells Lane, in a southerly direction for a distance of approx 46 metres.

Mead End: Both sides, from a point 16.5 metres west of the property boundary between Nos 3 and 5 Mead End, in a westerly direction for a distance of approx 23 metres.

Broadmead: Both sides, from a point 15 metres west of the property boundary between Nos 2a and 2 Broadmead, in a westerly direction for a distance of approx 15 metres.

Coppice Mead: Both sides, from a point 11 metres west of the property boundary between Nos 1 and 2 Coppice Mead, in a westerly direction for a distance of approx 15 metres.

Date of Operation: The Order will come into operation on the 19th April 2010.

<u>Further Details</u> of the Order and a plan showing the lengths of road affected may be examined during normal office hours at the Customer Service Centre, The Old Magistrates Court, 4 Saffron Road, Biggleswade and at normal opening hours at Biggleswade Library, Chestnut Avenue, Biggleswade..

<u>High Court Challenge:</u> Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant Section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the ground that any requirement of that Section had not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the 16th April 2010 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
