MODIFICATION ORDER 2004

On 31 March 2006 The Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs confirmed the above-named Order without modification.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:

adding to them part of Footpath No. 9 Westoning which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0185 3218 (Order map - point B), where it has a junction with Wood End Lane, generally south east for approx 10 metres to OS GR TL 0187 3217 (Order map - point A) where it has a junction with the part of Footpath No 9 Westoning already shown on the Definitive Map. The footpath has a width of 1.5m (5 feet) as shown on the Ordnance Survey 25" map, 2nd Edition, 1961.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the offices of Countryside Access Services, Bedfordshire County Council, County Hall, Caudwell Street, Bedford and may be inspected free of charge between 9.00am and 5.00pm on Mondays to Thursdays and between 9.00am and 4.00pm on Fridays. Copies of the Order and map may be purchased.

The Order came into force on 31 March 2006 but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 12(1) of Schedule 15 to the Act within 6 weeks from 16 April 2006 make an application to the High Court.
